- 8:00 to 8:50 a.m. **Changes in Retinal Anatomy Over the Course of Alzheimers Disease** - Review the neuropathology of Alzheimers disease AD & use this information to identify the most likely anatomic markers of the disease that are thought to be present within the retina.
